ORDER

COMES NOW the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy ("the Board"), by and through the undersigned members, and, following a full and fair hearing before the Board on July 28, 1995, in Montgomery, in the matter of the complaint against Richard Eric Craft, Certificate No. 2166, makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in support of this Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is a duly certified public accountant in the State of Alabama, and was so certified at all times relevant to the complaint.
2. Respondent received notice of the hearing, but was not present at the appointed time and place. Therefore, a hearing was held in his absence pursuant to Code of Alabama 1975, § 41-22-12(c).
3. Documentary evidence introduced by the State established that Respondent was convicted of the felony of first degree theft of property on or about April 10, 1995, in Chambers County Circuit Court.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

On the basis of the above Findings of Fact, the Board concludes that Richard Eric Craft has violated §§ 34-1-1, et seq., Code of Alabama 1975, as follows:

4. The acts of the respondent constitute the conviction of a crime, an element of which is fraud or dishonesty, under the laws of Alabama in violation of § 34-1-12(a)(5), Code of Alabama 1975.

5. The acts of the respondent constitute a conviction of a felony under the laws of the State of Alabama in violation of § 34-1-12(6), Code of Alabama 1975.


It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by this Board that the license, registration, certificate and/or permit to practice of the respondent be REVOKED.


