ORDER

This matter is presented to the Board upon a complaint against the Respondent which came to be heard on January 26, 1996, in Montgomery, Alabama. Respondent was present at the hearing. After a full and fair hearing, the Board finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is a certified public accountant properly permitted to do business in this state and was such at all times relevant to the complaint.
2. On January 10, 1995, the Grand Jury of Fulton Superior Court, Fulton County, Georgia, entered a true bill indictment number Z68032 against the Respondent for the offense of theft by taking.
3. On June 22, 1995, Respondent entered into a negotiated plea agreement in the Superior Court of Fulton County, Fulton County, Georgia.
4. Pursuant to the negotiated plea agreement, Respondent was sentence under First Offender Act (Ga. Laws 1968, p. 324), to confinement for ten (10) years which may be served on probation.
5. Respondent was also ordered to pay restitution, a fine and all court costs, and to complete five hundred (500) hours of community service.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The facts found above constitute the violation of Section 34-1-12(a)(6), Code of Alabama 1975.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED by the Board that:


a. Respondent's certificate and permit to practice are hereby REVOKED.

b. Respondent may apply to the Board for reinstatement of his certificate and permit to practice (i) upon satisfactory proof of the completion of his probation and sentence, or when he is otherwise discharged for the offense for which the negotiated plea agreement was entered and has been released by order of the Superior Court of Fulton County, Fulton County; Georgia; and (ii) when his civil rights have been restored; and upon payment of a fine of one thousand (\$1,000) dollars.
